



Tower Crew Foreman

Job Description:

Tower Crew Foremen will manage the day-to-day activities of a group of Tower Technicians and will work directly with climbing and working on communications towers for the purpose of installing, replacing and repairing antenna systems equipment. Also, Tower Crew Foremen will work with their crew to perform tower maintenance. They will act as a team leader and mentor to less experienced Tower Technicians. Tower Crew Foremen must be able to follow instructions accurately and complete assigned courses of action safely.

Tower Crew Foremen must have knowledge of the hazards associated with tower climbing, construction equipment and working on or near energized lines and equipment. They must be able to use and care for hand tools and mechanical equipment. They will travel extensively throughout the mid-American states.

Requirements:

- The ability to climb tall structures (100 feet or more) with 50 lb. load.
- Communicate orally and in writing
- Must have 3+ years of experience climbing and working on towers.
- Successfully complete the Tower Technician Training Program.
- Must be a well-organized started with a strong attention to detail.
- Willingness to take hands on approach in leading their team through demonstration.
- Must have experience with Anritsu Site Master, Andrew, PPC, tower mapping and antenna equipment.
- Must have experience stacking self-support towers, install waveguide, antennas and microwave dishes.
- Current Comtrain or equivalent certification in Tower Climbing Safety and Rescue Certification, OSHA trained, safety trained, Anritsu certified and First AID/CPR trained.

- Must understand RF Awareness, replacement and maintenance of coax, jumpers, TMA's, connectors and weatherproofing techniques
- Highly organized and be able to effectively report verbally and written reports back to the Construction Manager.
- Must have experience with completing "close out" packages.
- Must have experience with customer interfacing and problem resolution.
- Must maintain level of excellence in crew's quality of work and mindset.
- Possession of a valid driver license and be able to pass the Motor Vehicle Record check
